In addition Mobile Veterinarian can be used as an extra backup for your main network database. Useful in areas of erratic power supply or weather conditions.

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A first-hand look at RxWorks Mobile Veterinarian Technology



As is usual in a horse practice I have a significant ambulatory component. For much of the day the four wheel drive is my office. Like other practitioners I need to record details of the consultation, review histories and invoice clients in a professional manner. Having the tools to do this at hand can be critical when judgements or treatments need to be made. For example patient records- it is not unusual for a client to be referring to an event several years prior and recollections vary considerably from recorded history. The problem of cash flow is also contained, simply by providing an invoice at the end of each visit and pricing always reflects current costs.

With 20 years experience of computerised veterinary practice, my personal observation is that with better computer interfaces, increased veterinary board guidelines and client expectations we tend to be better at recording histories, observations and client instructions, and actually want to do it. The days of 5 words on a KISS file are long gone.

I have been using the vetaid / RxWorks product for the last 13 years from a laptop in the vehicle. The advantages of this are familiar, however the drawbacks were also problematic. Having the main database with me while I was out of the office meant that the staff during these times could not enter payments, counter-sales, drug supplies or access up to date histories.

Leaving the laptop office-bound on the network was not a realistic solution.

Thankfully RxWorks has saved my sanity with the release of Mobile Veterinarian. All the functionality I require in the field remains and the staff in the hospital has full access to all the tools. Record entry is now a single step and data transfer from the field is almost seamless. The sharing of the data entry workload is now a reality, and I have more time to spend with my family.

Bonuses that I did not expect: more of the program's features were utilised than previously; new clients were added to the system prior to my initial visit; appointment notes are automatically updated onto the history screen- helps in addressing all of the questions or requests made at the time of booking that might otherwise have been missed; the use of the attachments feature retrieves lab reports, photos and letters instantly in their original form from the best possible filing place.

Being back on a full time network has allowed me to run a terminal at home, this helps to accurately deal with the telephone traffic that is constant at either end of the day, and to do my paper work without going back to the office.
